Water management in Michigan and Indiana is 🛦 changing. Where in the past there was a common focus on drainage, there are now multiple concerns spanning a wide spectrum that includes MS4 water 🌢 quality standards, streambank erosion concerns, flooding, and much more. Drainage officials that at one time primarily worked to insure drainage of agricultural land are now being asked to consider their **b** regulated drains as part of a larger drainage network, and that stream network has multiple users wanting the stream to provide a wide range of functions. The variety of potential issues that can develop from A stream and river management in this new environment has created a need for more integrated management that considers both water quality and b water quantity, and the changing landscape.
